- > Ask the helpline about enrollment helpers in your community.
- Many public libraries offer computer access, as well as paper applications.

## Get ready to enroll

Before you start the enrollment process, gather the basic information you'll need for every member of your household who needs coverage:

- Social Security numbers
- Employer and income information (pay stubs or tax returns)
- Current health policy numbers

And review basic insurance terms like:

**co-pay** – the amount an insured person pays for each doctor visit, procedure or prescription.

**deductible** – the total amount an insured person has to pay in one year before the insurance starts paying.

**premium** – the amount you pay each month for health insurance coverage.
